In short, God is love and as such He has no higher expectation of us than that we love one another.

Love is the glue of the communion of saints. Love unites us with God, physically and spiritually. Love takes that union with Him and builds up a genuine communion of saints, a people who reflect the love of God with each other first, then the world.

Love makes the Christian God different from all other "gods." Love makes no demands, but the man-made "gods" of the world make demands all the time. God, in His love, threw all the demands of the Law on Himself, on His Son, so that you would be free, free to love Him and love one another. Love proves the Bible's God to be genuine.

Love proves Christians to be genuine as well. Jesus said they (the world) will know you are my disciples by your love (John 13:35). Just as our God of love is unique and genuine, so

our lives as Christians are proven genuine by love. The world cannot come up with any better way of living than what we have in God's love in Christ Jesus.

Love proves Christian congregations to be genuine as well. In our congregation we practice sharing in the love of God with one another. We pray together. We praise together. We forgive one another. We bear one another's burdens. We lay aside our own sinful wants and desires for the health of the other person and the congregation as a whole.

God has freed us from our debt to Him so that we would be left with only one debt we owe one another. The gift of love. God help us as a congregation to be people of love for Him and for one another.


