# SEEING THROUGH THE EARS



"Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path."
Psalm 119:105

To be a Christian is to be a hearer of the Word. In the "Table Of Duties" of the Small Catechism, Luther chose to refer to Christians not as Christians, not as believers, but rather as hearers. The Table of Duties was a catalog of Scripture verses to teach Christians their responsibilities in all of the realms of life. It taught the 4th Commandment as a two way street. For instance, it taught what children owe their parents and what parents owe their children. In the realm of the Church, the Table of Duties provided Scriptures to teach what hearers owe their pastors and what pastors owe their hearers.

But most significant is that Luther was teaching that to be a Christian was to be a continual hearer of the Word, one who is always about the business of hearing the Word and growing in it. To Luther, one of the chief tasks of the Christian was to be hearing the Word.

David, in Psalm 119, shows us just how pervasive that Word of God was in his own life. Statements like, "I love your law," "I seek to keep (treasure) your decrees," "I meditate on your Word both day and night" depict a faith that not only is centered on the Word, but finds it the greatest treasure in life. For David, not to have God's Word to meditate on would be like not having air enough to breathe.

In the Word, we learn to see through our ears. The Word has only been accessible to all of us in printed form since the late 1700s. (It was expensive to own a printed Bible prior to the invention of more modern book manufacturing technology). The Word was designed to be preached by prophets, apostles, and later pastors. That means it was designed to be heard by believers. The Word is as much a community thing in the Church as the Lord's Supper.

In hearing the Good News of God's salvation, the Christian sees the fullness of God's love, mercy, and grace. In hearing the words spoken from the pulpit, the Christian learns to see Jesus as He is given us in the Scriptures. In hearing the words spoken over bread and wine, the Christian learns to see Jesus present in His Body and Blood... forgiving our sins to boot! In hearing all of it Sunday to Sunday, the Christian learns to see God's great love at a cross and an empty tomb. The Christian learns not to fear sin, death, and the power of the devil.

God's Word is a lamp to our feet and a light to our path. It makes the way visible in a darkened and fallen world with much evil in it. He who has ears, let him hear! And let that hearing clarify our vision as we move ahead into eternal glory.


